A new revolutionary technology has arrived, it is now possible to be contactable on one phone number even if your at work, home, out and about or even abroad maybe on holiday! With an 070 number your phone calls will "Follow You (call hunt)" wherever you should go! How do 070 numbers work?

070 phone numbers route your calls to your personal phone numbers you supply, when somebody phones you on your 070 number then their call is diverted to one or more of your phone numbers this can include landlines and mobile phones. 070 phone numbers are classed as "Follow Me / Call hunt" phone numbers, as if there is no answer on the first phone number then the telephone call can be re-directed to up to another two phone numbers! This could be your secretary, partner, a colleague or even another one of your personal phone numbers. Our 070 numbers can even be programmed on a time basis so calls in the evening or weekend can be re-diverted to an alternative phone number or simply blocked (times chosen by you)

070 Phone Number Advantages...

- Keep the same phone number when you move
- Day to day and time based call diversion available

- 070 Numbers keep your personal numbers private (home, private office etc)

Call Management Voicemail: A FREE optional extra with this number is our voice to email service, this service converts voicemail messages left on your 070 number into .WAV files & routes them to your e-mail address or Online Call Management Account in real time! **Virtual Receptionist:** This FREE service greets callers upon connection. Our default message is "please hold whilst we connect your call" Messages can be personalised. **Call Diversion:** Calls to your 070 can be diverted to up to 3 different numbers and if necessary your calls can be diverted to different numbers in the evening or weekend. **URGENT NOTIFICATION** Ofcom (The UK Telecoms Regulator) recently made changes to the way calls to 070 Personal Numbers are handled. Ofcom have regulated that carriers must play a FREE TO AIR MESSAGE similar to: "You have dialed a personal number which starts 070. This is not a mobile number. 070 calls from BT cost up to 50p per minute or a fixed fee of up to 51p, charges from other operators mobiles or payphones may vary. You have not been charged for this message" This is taken care of by the carrier who routes the phone calls so no need to worry about people not knowing what the call costs.
